Follow in the footsteps of Michael Portillo in this rail tour down the length of Italy to Sicily. This tour encompasses some spectacularly scenic rail journeys: you cross the Alps by train, follow the Mediterranean coast south of Naples into the toe of Italy and then you witness the crossing of the Strait of Messina with your train on the ferry! Travel by train from London to Zurich where you spend one night, then continue on to Milan for another night, enjoying the stunning Alpine scenery en route. Make the journey southwards through Italy to Naples, where you stay for one night, before travelling around Italy's toe to your final destination in Sicily. Spend three nights in Taormina at the Hotel Villa Belvedere and then return to the UK by plane.

### DAY ONE: London to Lucerne by rail

Begin your rail holiday, leaving London at about 8am by Eurostar to Paris, before changing stations and continuing on the high speed TGV Lyria train to Basel. An easy change here takes you to Lucerne where you arrive at about 7.00pm. Check into the Hotel Wilden Mann where you spend one night. Spend the evening exploring Lucerne's pretty Old Town on foot, crossing the river over the iconic Chapel Bridge.

#### DAY TWO: Lucerne to Milan by rail

You have the morning to explore Lucerne and set off to Milan around midday. This takes you on the spectacular Gotthard railway route through the Alps, passing striking scenery and traversing wonderful feats of engineering. Once through the Gotthard Pass, you're in the Italian part of Switzerland heading towards Lugano which is located on another magnificent lake. From here it's a short distance to the Italian border at Chiasso. Arrive in Milan around 3.30pm and check in at the Baglioni Hotel Carlton where you spend one night. This afternoon you might like to enjoy some retail therapy on the fashionable streets of Milan, visit the Cathedral or check for performances at La Scala theatre.

### DAY THREE: Milan to Naples by rail

Leaving Milan around 10.00am, your train heads further south, passing through Bologna, Florence and Rome before arriving into Naples in the early afternoon. This allows you to spend the afternoon sightseeing, perhaps visiting the Archeological Museum which houses most of the artefacts from Pompeii and Herculaneum or wandering around the Centro Storico. You spend one night in Naples at the Grand Hotel Vesuvio.

#### DAY FOUR: Naples to Sicily by rail

You leave Naples behind just before 10.00am to travel by train to Taormina-Giardini, following the dramatic coast south through Campania, Basilicata and Calabria to reach the Strait of Messina where your train boards the ferry for the crossing to Sicily. Arrive into Taormina late afternoon and transfer to the Hotel Villa Belvedere where you spend three nights.

#### **DAYS FIVE AND SIX: Taormina**

We suggest at least two days to explore Sicily from your base in Taormina. The town stands at an altitude of 250m above sea level and forms a perfect balcony overlooking the sea towards Mount Etna. A popular destination, it is renowned for its surprisingly peaceful atmosphere, beautiful monuments and tranquil gardens. A visit to the ancient Greco-Roman theatre here is a must. For travellers who want some time by the beach, it is also possible to descend by cable car to Taormina Mare at the bottom of the cliff.

#### DAY SEVEN: Fly back to the UK

Leave your hotel in Taormina to take a flight from Catania to London Gatwick.

#### **LUCERNE**

#### Hotel Wilden Mann 4 star

The Wilden Mann has been in the hospitality trade for 500 years, bringing excellent quality of service and charm each of its quests. With just 48 rooms spread across 6 different houses, the atmosphere is one of a homefrom-home and this hotel offers the perfect balance of historic and old-world elegance with modern facilities. It is located just a stones throw from the iconic Chapel Bridge and Nadelwehr and is only a 10 minute walk from the train station, making it the perfect stopover in the enchanting old streets of Lucerne.

#### MILAN

#### Baglioni Hotel Carlton 5 star

This luxury five star hotel can be found discreetly tucked away on the Via della Spiga, Milan's most fashionable shopping street, and the Via Montenapoleone, the cathedral and famous La Scala theatre are a short distance away. Inside, discover an intimate and sophisticated atmosphere with marble floors and dark wood wall panels. The hotel provides outstanding levels of service and facilities, including the historice II Baretto al Baglioni Restaurant which serves national dishes with Mediterranean influences.

#### **NAPLES**

#### Grand Hotel Vesuvio 5 star

The Grand Hotel Vesuvio is a very comfortable property that offers enviable views across the bay to Vesuvius from its privileged waterfront position. The hotel has 250 bright and cheerful rooms furnished in a modern, Mediterranean style. It also has a large outdoor swimming pool with solarium and sunbeds and offers quests a choice of four restaurants in which to sample both regional and international dishes.



#### TAORMINA, SICILY

#### Hotel Villa Belvedere 4 star

The Villa Belvedere is a charming and comfortable hotel, centrally located in the town of Taormina. Occupying a historic Sicilian villa, the hotel's position perched high on the hill-side offers stunning views across the bay and the countryside towards Mount Etna. The bedrooms are simple but pretty, and several of them have balconies with table and chairs. Tasty light lunches are served on the terrace by the pool, whilst there is a delightful choice of restaurants within easy reach in the town.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **OUR TOURS**

Our rail tours are for individuals travelling on their own or in their own family group. You do not join a group and you are not escorted.

#### **FLEXIBLE ARRANGEMENTS**

Our arrangements are very flexible in that you choose to travel on any day you want, subject to availability of trains and hotels. As mentioned above, additional nights can be added at any point.

#### **EUROSTAR**

A rail holiday to Italy starts with a journey by Eurostar from London St Pancras, Ebbsfleet or Ashford stations in the UK to either Paris Gare du Nord or Lille Europe. In summer months there are direct trains on Saturdays from London St Pancras to Avignon with no change required.

Eurostar offers almost hourly departures every day, allowing you to travel from the centre of London to the centre of Paris on the same train in three hours. Not all trains stop at the Ebbsfleet and Ashford stations in Kent, but parking is plentiful at both stations and it allows you to avoid London.

Check-in is 30 minutes prior to departure, customs formalities are completed before boarding and there is no limit to the amount of baggage that can be taken on board. The Eurostar trains themselves have 8 coaches which are split into Standard Class, Standard Premier and Business Premier as well as 2 cafeterias. Standard Premier customers are served a light cold meal and enjoy a more spacious environment than Standard Class, while Business Premier customers receive a hot meal and unlimited beverages as well as lounge access.

#### TRAIN TIMES

We have planned our itineraries based on train times that work day by day at the time of planning which can be up to a year before you travel. Usually train times stay more or less the same every day, season by season. The times we have planned will be discussed with you at the time you enquire about the holiday and they are detailed to you in your written holiday quotation. It may be that the timetable changes between the planning of the itinerary and when you come to book but we can always adjust the itinerary to suit the actual train times and any requirements you have for particular times of travel.

#### FIRST OR SECOND CLASS

We will automatically include travel in second class but lots of our clients do upgrade to first class service. On Eurostar this is called Premier Standard for leisure travellers as it gives you an upgraded on-board service and more spacious seating but without paying for the fully-flexible business tickets. On the Inter-city trains, upgrading to first class gives you more spacious seating with increased legroom. The price of upgrading varies from route to route but is something that is not always proportionately a lot more on the price of the overall holiday, so well-worth considering.

#### **TRANSFERS**

Transfers in Paris between stations and from the station to each hotel are not automatically included in the price of the holiday. In Paris most clients choose to take a taxi between the stations rather than go on the Metro but we can arrange a private car with driver to take you in between. This is quite useful if you are a family group that can't fit into one Paris taxi.
